GOD, the Father

We believe that God, the Father is the first person of the triune Godhead. He is the eternal Father of our Lord Jesus Christ and is the author of salvation; thus, He freely gave His Son as gift to all of mankind to pay the penalty for the sins mankind had no way of paying.

GOD, the Son

We believe that God, the Son is Jesus Christ, who is the second person of the triune Godhead, has eternal existence, and is One with the Father. Jesus Christ is the visible image of the invisible God. In His incarnation, Jesus Christ was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary; thus, He united the divine and human natures being born fully God and fully man, yet without sin into one unique person of Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ is God's personal Word to mankind; He is sinless and the Savior and Lord of all mankind. His voluntary, perfect substitutionary death on our behalf on a Roman cross is the only atonement for the past, present, and future sins of mankind. Jesus rose bodily from the dead in three days and was seen by hundreds of eyewitnesses. His death, burial, and resurrection rescued all of mankind from a spiritual death and an eternal separation from God in Hell. Jesus Christ, the Son of God, not only provided eternal salvation but also an eternal relationship with God, the Father. After His ascent into Heaven, He currently sits at the right hand of the Father where He presently mediates as the believers' Advocate and High Priest. He is sovereign in power and Lordship. Jesus Christ, the Son of God will imminently return in power and glory for all of mankind to bow down before Him as Lord.

GOD, the Holy Spirit

Our Gift of Salvation

Receiving God's free gift of salvation through belief and faith in Christ Jesus results in the Holy Spirit coming to indwell in the spirit of the new believer forever and allowing him/her to communicate with God in prayer.
